- 6. Go outside and whistle or sing the different bird songs that you hear.
- 7. Build and instrument out of different things that you can find around your house (ex. Things you can shake, hit or grate)
- 8. Listen to your favourite song and write down 3 reasons why you like it.
- 9. Try a new radio station. There are jazz and classical radio stations, and French
- 10. Create a hand clapping game with another member of your family.
- 11. Listen to a piece of classical music (radio, YouTube, etc) and draw a picture about how it makes you feel.
- 12. Create a dance to a favourite song. Teach it to your family, or perform it for them.
- 13. Go outside and write down all the different sounds you can hear. It's called a sound walk!

- 14. Write about the music you think a character from a book you've read would like. What would it sound like? Why?
- 15. Draw a line that moves all around a page. Using your voice, sing what that line would sound like.
- 16. Sing a song you know, but turn it into a lullaby. Think about how you would need to change it. (speed, volume, feeling)

- 17. Read a book and make up a song for one of the characters.
- 18. Find a song you like and create body percussion to go along with it (clap, stomp, snap etc).
- 19. Listen to a song, draw what you hear.
